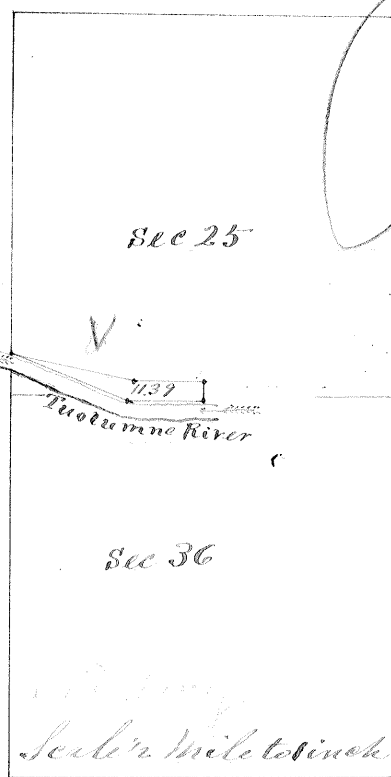

East 14.20 chs, to $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line thence run on $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line S 6° E 3.50 chs,
to the Right Bank of the Tuolumne River Meander down Stream
run S 88° W 6.00 chs, N 68° W 26.00 chs, to the place of beginning.
Run by the true Meridian Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 30'$ East
Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the Legislature
concerning Swamp and Overflowed Lands Approved
April 18th 1859 and the instructions of the Surveyor
General
