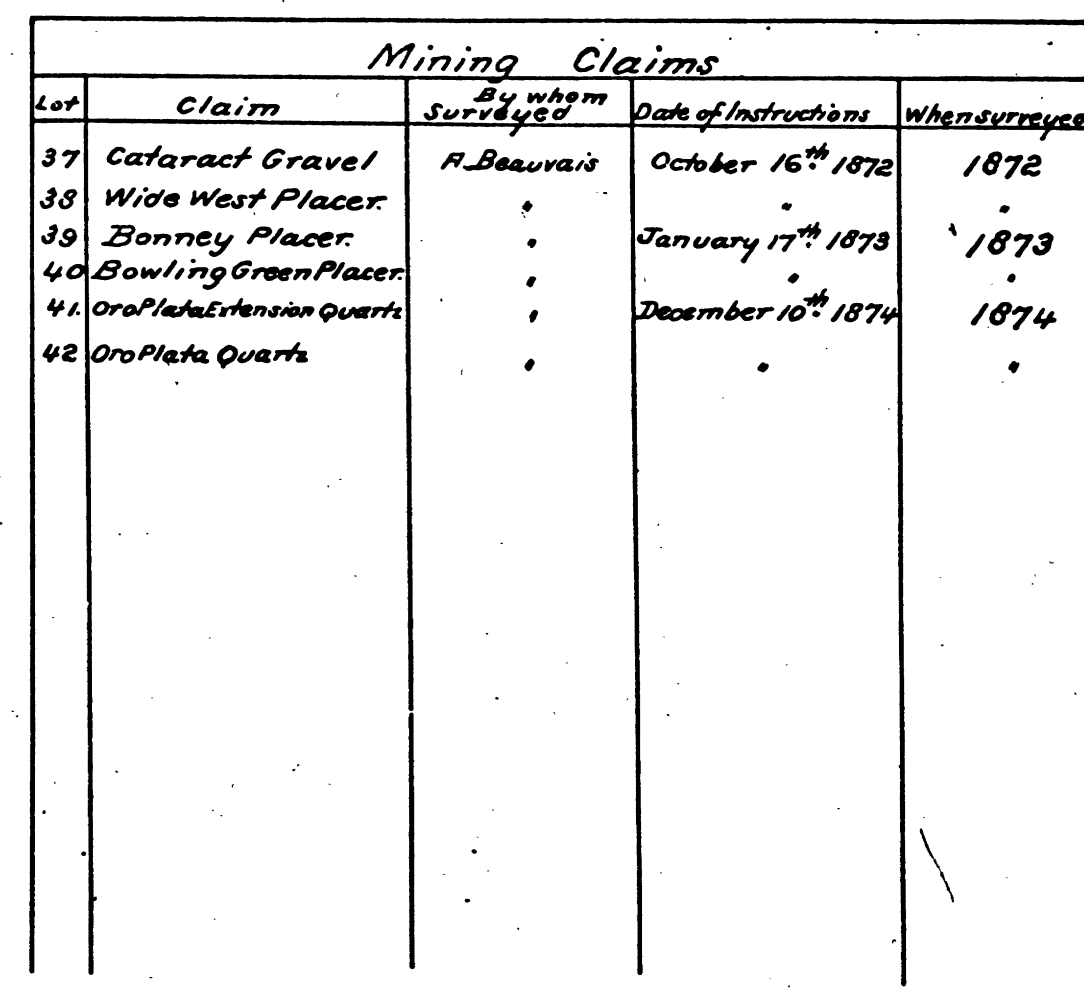


Mount Diablo Meridian.
